



We hope you and your family are staying healthy and doing well, we missed seeing you! We are happy to announce that we will be reopening our office to regular appointments starting May 19th. Due to the severe shortage in protective equipment we will be prioritizing appointments based on urgency and have only limited appointments available for routine care until supplies are no longer restricted. Please contact us as soon as possible to reserve your appointment time.

In order to keep our staff and patients safe during the ongoing pandemic we have implemented the following changes in addition to our normal procedures.

- Our office will communicate with you before your appointment to ask you some health screening questions. If you have any COVID related symptoms or have had close contact with someone who is symptomatic we ask you to please reschedule your appointment until you are symptom free.
- Masks or cloth face covering is required in all areas of our office, except when treatment is being provided. If you do not have one we will provide you with a mask to use during your visit.
- Upon arrival you will be asked to use hand sanitizer and have a temperature screening done with a forehead thermometer.
- Magazines, toys and other public items have been removed and seating in our lobby is limited to allow for proper social distancing. We ask that you limit the companions you bring to one other person.
- We have limited the number of patients we will see per day to better manage personal contacts and this may mean that you will be offered fewer options for scheduling your appointment. We apologize for any inconvenience.
- If you prefer to wait in your car, please call our office when you arrive, and we will call or txt you when we are ready to seat you.
- In addition to our normal rigorous infection control protocols we have implemented many other safety precautions such as a medical air purification system that will filter out virus particles at 0.1 micron, pre-procedure oral rinse with a hydrogen peroxide solution, daily health screening for staff members, and disinfecting commonly touched surfaces and items between each patient.

We are excited to be able to resume regular care for our patients in a safe environment. We are thankful for your continuing trust in us and look forward to seeing each of you soon.
